SCARBOROUGH TO FILEY (THE CLEVELAND WAY)



Distance 10.5 miles

Time 4.5 hours walking 45 mins cycling

Level moderate, mainly flat on cinder tracks

The Cleveland Way National Trail is a 109 mile (175 km) walking and cycling route through beautiful and ever changing landscapes and scenery. It starts at Helmsley and ends on Filey Brigg. The Trail offers the best of both worlds, heather moorland and stunning coastal scenery.

This part of the trail takes you from the lovely seaside town of Scarborough to the picturesque old Victorian resort of Filey. It has some stunning cliff and coastal scenery to appreciate as you saunter or cycle through to Filey.

The Cleveland Way is 109 miles/175km long, with points of interest every step of the way, enjoying the North York Moors and Coast. The Cleveland Way heads across the stunning North York Moors, before reaching the coast at Saltburn. From here there's a visual feast along the dramatic North Yorkshire coastline to Filey, passing through old fishing villages, such as Robin Hood's Bay and lively coastal towns such as Scarborough and Whitby. The whole of the route is away from roads and well-signed throughout, but an up-to-date map or GPS mapping is always useful.

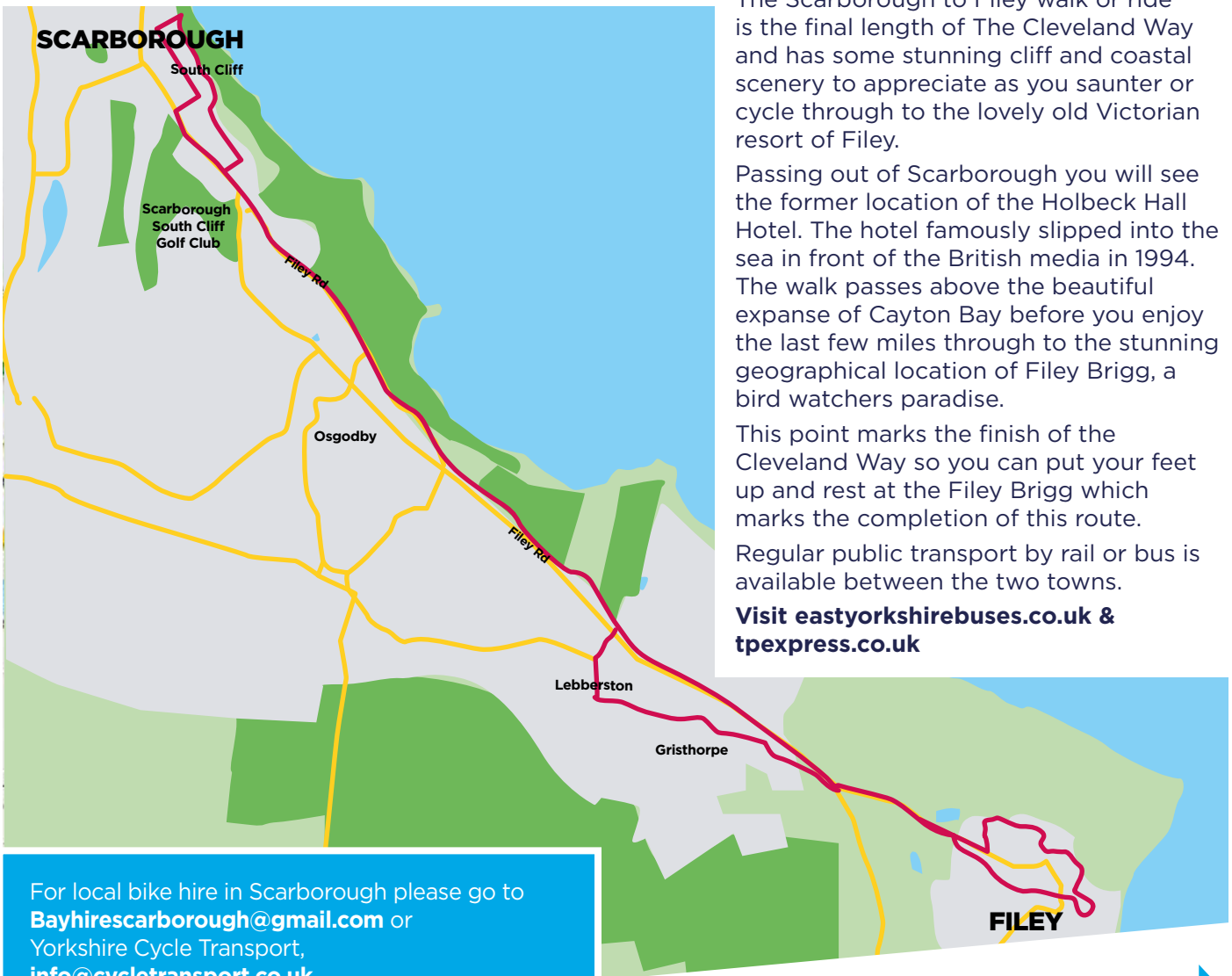
The Scarborough to Filey walk or ride is the final length of The Cleveland Way and has some stunning cliff and coastal scenery to appreciate as you saunter or cycle through to the lovely old Victorian resort of Filey.

Passing out of Scarborough you will see the former location of the Holbeck Hall Hotel. The hotel famously slipped into the sea in front of the British media in 1994. The walk passes above the beautiful expanse of Cayton Bay before you enjoy the last few miles through to the stunning geographical location of Filey Brigg, a bird watchers paradise.

This point marks the finish of the Cleveland Way so you can put your feet up and rest at the Filey Brigg which marks the completion of this route.

Regular public transport by rail or bus is available between the two towns.
